
Literacy Builds Confidence

ADULT SECONDARY EDUCATION

Our Adult Secondary Education (ASE) to prepare for the GED, to reinforce or gain higher education. Instruction is tailored to meet the student's needs and schedule.

Maria H. is originally from Vera Cruz Mexico, and lives with her husband in Siler City. Maria is an extremely motivated student who completed her GED last

Our workforce soft skills program helps employees, under-employed individuals, and the unemployed to learn the "soft skills" that are expected of them in the workplace (i.e.: communication, teamwork, networking, problem solving, critical thinking, understanding cultural differences, and professionalism).

Prior to interviewing, Maria participated in Chatham Literacy's workforce soft skills training. 


