

## **How to Be a Valued Sponsor in 2019**

Chatham County Literacy Council (Chatham Literacy) helps adults living or working in Chatham County acquire the literacy and educational skills they need to read to their children, continue on to higher learning, obtain a job, function successfully in our community and health care system, and become U.S. citizens if they are not already.

We have two fundraisers in 2019: one in the spring and one in the fall. All proceeds fund Chatham Literacy's free one-on-one and small-group instruction.

- **Spring for Literacy Luncheon**, Wednesday, April 10, 2019 from 11 am 2 pm at the Governors Club Clubhouse. Local author Frances Mayes will keynote. Frances Mayes is the author of seven books about Tuscany, including the now-classic *Under the Tuscan Sun*. Mayes will share about her new book *See You in the Piazza*, release date of March 12, 2019. On average, 200 community residents and dignitaries participate in this FUNdraiser.
- **Spring Raffle.** To make things even more fun, we have added a separate but related raffle for a trip for two to Italy. The winning ticket will be drawn on April 10 at the Spring for Literacy Luncheon. Winner does not need to be present to win, nor be a luncheon attendee. Only 250 tickets will be sold. Tickets are \$100 each.
- **Fall for Literacy Luncheon**, date to be determined. Location will be Siler City. Registration will be a \$60 donation. The program is still to be determined. On average, 75 people enjoy good company and conversation, delicious food, and a presentation by a renowned, local author.
