Mr. Mott will talk about his journey as a writer and share about his new book, *Hell of a Book*, a 2021 National Book Award winner. Mott’s book is a story that goes to the heart of racism, police violence, and the hidden costs exacted upon Black Americans, and America as a whole. Mott is the author of four novels. *The Returned*, Jason’s debut novel, was adapted by Brad Pitt’s production company, Plan B. On average, 250 community members and dignitaries attend. Registration will be a \$75 donation/person and will include many opportunities to win game and door prizes.
