From US 15-501:

Just south of Chapel Hill at the southern junction of US 15-501 and the 15-501 Bypass

Turn south onto Mt. Carmel Church Road

Go approximately 3 miles

Turn right at the traffic signal (Governors Drive) and enter through the stone and ironwork gate that is the entrance to Governors Club.

From Highway 64:

Just east of Jordan Lake in Chatham County, turn North at the traffic signal onto Farrington Road

Farrington Road will take you all the way to Governors Club, crossing 2 sections of Jordan Lake. Farrington Road becomes Mt. Carmel Church Road at the intersection of Farrington Mill Road about 1-2 miles South of the Club entrance.

Turn left at the traffic signal (Governors Drive) through the stone and ironwork gate that is the entrance to Governors Club.
